

PENN WRESTLERS TRIUMPH.

Columbia Grapplers Defeated in Dual Meet, 21 to 6.

Pennsylvania wrestlers defeated a team of Columbia grapplers in a dual meet held in the Morningside Heights gymnasium last night by 21 to 6. The Quaker representatives won four bouts outright and gained a draw in the other three. The best bout of the evening was between Barrish of Columbia and D. Wolf of Penn in the unlimited weight class. Both displayed exceptional knowledge of the mat sport and were so closely matched that no decision other than a draw was possible. Keterer, Hyman, Rose, and McDermott of Penn were victors.
