

Penn Wrestlers Beat Columbia.

PHILADELPHIA, March 1. — The University of Pennsylvania wrestling team defeated Columbia here today, 12 to 10. Pennsylvania was awarded decisions in the 115, 125, 158 pound and unlimited weight classes. The only fall in the meet was won by Captain Barish of Columbia, who threw Pendleton, Pennsylvania, in the 175-pound bout in 8 minutes. The Columbia Captain also won a decision in the 145-pound class. Ashby, Pennsylvania, won the 158-pound event from Kirkland, Columbia, and the heavyweight bout from Fargo.
