

YALE DEFEATS PENN.

Blue Sextet Wins at Hockey by 8 to 3 Score—Griscom Stars.

NEW HAVEN, Conn., Jan. 11.—Yale defeated Pennsylvania tonight at hockey 8 to 3, outskating and outplaying the Quakers in every department of play. The visitors were crippled by the absence through recent injury to their star, Percy Wanamaker, whose brilliant game was a large factor in defeating the Elis in Philadelphia during the Christmas vacation.

Captain Pringle's attack was the most valuable individual play contributed by the visitors, while Captain Griscom's all-around game was perhaps the most brilliant of his Yale career.
