

LEHIGH WRESTLERS WIN.

**Competing Under New Rules, Defeat
Penn Team by 23 to 8.**

BETHLEHEM, Pa., Feb. 3.—Competing for the first time under the new rules of the Intercollegiate Wrestling Association, the Lehigh team decisively defeated the University of Pennsylvania here tonight by the score of 23 to 8.

All of Lehigh's victories were decided by falls except one. Of the seven bouts Lehigh won five, four by falls and one on a time decision. Penn scored one fall and one decision.
