BETHLEHEM, Penn., Nov. 8.—The University of Pennsylvania soccer team tied with Haverford for the first place in the Pennsylvania State intercollegiate Soccer League by defeating Lehigh University today by the score of 4 goals to 1. The Penn dribblers, taking advantage of every opportunity, rolled up a most decisive score.

At times Lehigh was brilliant, but most every forward movement was frustrated before it passed the fullbacks, and then when shots were accurately directed at the goal, Callahan, the visitor's custodian, was equal to the occasion.

Binns, the Penn centre forward, who registered three of his team's four goals, was the most brilliant forward on the field.
