PHILADELPHIA, Nov. 14.—All five of Pennsylvania's soccer forwards tallied at least one goal in defeating the New York University eleven, 9 to 1, on River Field today. Binns was the high scorer, tallying three goals. Captain Boos was a close second with two, while Gentle, Shelmire, Dougherty and MacDonald each counted once.

N. Y. U.'s lone score came in the final period on a nicely executed corner kick, Shapiro jumped high in the air and heading the ball into goal. It was only the brilliant saves of Mallahein that kept the Penn forwards from scoring many additional goals.
