

PENN TEAM VICTOR AT SOCCER, 6 TO 1

University Triumphs Over Field Club of Englewood by Mysti- fying Combination Play.

ENGLEWOOD, N. J., Oct. 2.—Sweeping all before them and displaying a grade of combination play which mystified the home defense, the soccer players of the University of Pennsylvania easily defeated the eleven of the Englewood Field Club, 6 goals to 1, here this afternoon. The collegians had demonstrated their superiority clearly by half-time, when they were leading by 4-1.

After ten minutes of play Schaefer, Penn's centre forward, shot the first goal from a mix-up. Pratt followed suit, five minutes later, and in another five minutes Schaefer went through again and the score stood at 3-0 for Pennsylvania. About midway Englewood scored as Mellor, centre forward for the home team, finally located Pennsylvania's net. Levy tallied for the collegians shortly before half time.
