

YALE BEATS NAVY IN SOCCER CONTEST

**Wins by 5 to 2 as Fletcher Stars
—Penn Downs Cornell by
4-1 Score.**

ANNAPOLIS, Md., Nov. 24.—With a clever scorer in Fletcher and a better all around team, the Yale soccer eleven beat the Naval Academy here today, 5 to 2. Yale scored all of its points before the Navy scored the first of its two.

After ten minutes of playing in the second quarter, Fletcher made a brilliant dribble for thirty-five yards and though stopped in front of the Navy goal, regained the ball and kicked it between the posts. A minute before the close of the half, Wylie scored again for Yale after Ashley and Harte had cleverly worked the ball down field.
