

LEHIGH WRESTLERS WIN.

Overwhelm Penn Squad, 28 to 3,
in Final Dual Meet of Year.

PHILADELPHIA, Pa., March 10.—Lehigh's wrestling squad wound up its dual meet season by trouncing the University of Pennsylvania wrestling squad, 28 to 3. The Bethlehem squad won five bouts by falls, only one bout going to the Penn team. Gabriel of Penn forced one bout to an extra period before losing, while Bogdan, Penn Captain, gained a time advantage victory.
