

LEHIGH WRESTLERS TOPPLE PENN, 26-13

**Mann of Losers Scores Fourth
Triumph by Pinning Peck,
Collegiate Champion.**

SOKOLIS VICTOR ON POINTS

**Shows 5-3 Margin Over Hirshberg
Though Each Scores One Fall
In the Unlimited Class.**

PHILADELPHIA, March 5.—Peter Peck, Lehigh's 165-pound intercollegiate wrestling champion, was thrown by Kenneth Mann of Penn, but the former team won the annual meet from the Red and Blue at the Palestra today, 26 to 13.

Mann, in gaining his fourth straight victory of the season, pinned Peck to the mat in 9 minutes 55 seconds with a full Nelson.

Captain Stan Sokolis, Penn's heavyweight, and Harold Hirshberg, 240-

pound Brown and White representative, each scored a fall in the unlimited class, but the former was credited with five points and the latter three, as his fall came faster than that of the up-Stater.
