

PENN WRESTLERS TRIUMPH

**Take Five of Eight Matches in
Beating Rutgers, 19 to 11.**

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NEW BRUNSWICK, N. J., Feb. 16.—University of Penn defeated Rutgers in wrestling today, 19 to 11.

The Quaker grapplers won five of the eight matches, two by falls and three by time advantages. The Scarlet's points were accounted for by Captain Buck Ackerman and Herb Seaman on decisions and by George Borden, Rutgers' undefeated heavy-weight, who scored two falls over Bernard Pollock.

118-Pound Class—Levin, Penn, defeated Deschu. Time advantage—3:56.

126-Pound Class—Moore, Penn, threw F. Van Houten in 9:35 with a half nelson and body hold.

135-Pound Class—Gordon, Penn, defeated Marucci. Time advantage—5:21.

145-Pound Class—Ackerman, Rutgers, defeated Taylor, two overtime periods, referee's decision.

155-Pound Class—Seaman, Rutgers, defeated Kantor. Time advantage—2:08.

165-Pound Class—Levin, Penn, defeated C. Van Houten. Time advantage—5:56.

175-Pound Class—Graham, Penn, threw Sherer in 3:41 with a figure four scissors and half nelson.

Unlimited Class—Borden, Rutgers, threw Pollock with a half nelson and body hold in 0:35 of the first period, and with the same hold in 1:35 of the second period.

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
