Lehigh University's wrestling team
returned to winning form tonight,
defeating the University of Penn-
sylvania grapplers in the final dual
meet of the season, 16 to 14.

Howell S. Scobey, the home
team's undefeated heavyweight,
pinned Pollack of Pennsylvania in
the last event to give Lehigh the
victory.
