Three Tigers Register Falls as
Penn Is Vanquished, 24 to 6.

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PRINCETON, N. J., Feb. 8.—Downing the University of Pennsylvania matmen, 24—6, Princeton's wrestling team scored its third straight victory of the year today in the university gymnasium.
