

SOCCER TITLE TO CORNELL

**Big Red Beats Penn, 4-3, in
Overtime for Ivy Crown**

PHILADELPHIA, Nov. 24 (AP)—
Cornell University won the Ivy
League soccer championship today
by defeating Pennsylvania, 4—3,
in an overtime battle at River
Field.

Gunter Meng, whose goal had
put Cornell ahead, 3—2, gave the
Big Red the victory with a goal in
the overtime period.

Joe McKinney also scored for
Cornell, while another goal was
tallied when Cornell's Ed Tappin
booted the ball and it deflected off
Penn's Don Cavanaugh into the
Penn goal.

Warren Stone, Phil Repeti and
Pat Welsh scored for Penn.
