

PENN TURNS BACK GEORGETOWN, 92-76

Beck's 22 Points Lead Quaker Quintet—Villanova Defeats Texas Wesleyan, 71 to 64

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 20 (AP)—Pennsylvania conquered Georgetown's five for a record-breaking 92-76 victory tonight before 3,175 fans at the Palestra.

In scoring their eleventh triumph in fifteen starts, the Pennsylvanians never trailed and were tied only once. Georgetown's Hoyas now have four victories and three losses.

The two-team total of 168 points snapped the old court standard of 163 set by Villanova and Tennessee here last Dec. 30.

The winning Quakers had a 25-17 lead after ten minutes, but were caught with eight minutes to go in the half when Georgetown knotted it at 27-27.

Then the Quakers moved out in front again and were never in trouble.

Penn Sophomore Center Ernie Beck topped the scorers with 22 points.

In the second game Villanova halted Texas Wesleyan, 71 to 64.

It was the thirteenth victory for the Wildcats and Texas Wesleyan's sixth setback in thirteen starts.
