

BECK'S 45 POINTS HELP PENN WIN

He Betters Lavelli's Eastern
League Record in 82-48
Rout of Harvard Five

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., Feb. 6 (AP)—Ernie Beck set a new Eastern Intercollegiate Basketball League individual scoring record of 45 points tonight while leading Penn to a 82-48 victory over Harvard.

The former mark of 40 was set by Tony Lavelli of Yale against Princeton in 1949.

Beck tossed in fourteen field goals and made good on all but two of his nineteen free shots, while turning the game into a one-man show.

The Crimson had no defense for the 6-foot-4-inch Philadelphian, who spent most of the game shooting with his back to the backboards. He also connected from outside with one-hand push shots and by driving it under the baskets.

Harvard managed to stay on fairly even terms until Beck broke the game wide open early in the third period by clicking with three rapid-fire field goals.

It was the Quakers' fifth victory in six league starts and Harvard's fourth straight loss in as many loop games.
