

SYRACUSE IS VICTOR OVER PENN BY 94-76

Orange Gains 13th Triumph
as Beck Stars—St. Francis
Five Wins Finale, 63-47

SYRACUSE, N. Y., March 5—Syracuse coasted to its thirteenth victory of the season tonight, defeating Pennsylvania, 94 to 76.

Ernie Beck, the Quakers' star center, broke the War Memorial Auditorium scoring record, netting 32 points.

The victory was the fifth straight for the Orange five, which led all the way without being threatened seriously. Bucky Roche paced the victors with 23 points, while Tom Huggins contributed 16.
