

## Penn Overtime Victor

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 6 (AP)

—Stu Greenleaf's long jump shot with four seconds remaining in an overtime period gave Penn a 58-57 victory over Brown tonight. Greenleaf had sent the game into overtime with another clutch basket.

Bob Alden's 25 points paced LaSalle to an 80-73 upset over St. Joseph's in the second game of the double-header.

Penn had blown an early 10-point lead in the opener, an Ivy League game, and with 20 seconds remaining was trailing, 49-47. Then Greenleaf hit from about 15 feet out. His game-winning basket came from twenty feet out.
