

QUAKERS SET BACK MIDDIES, 64 TO 53

**Mlkvy and Graham Tally 18
Points Each—Princeton Is
Victor Over Temple, 74-64**

ANNAPOLIS, Md., Dec. 6—

The University of Pennsylvania picked up its second triumph without defeat by outscoring Navy, 64—53, in a basketball game today.

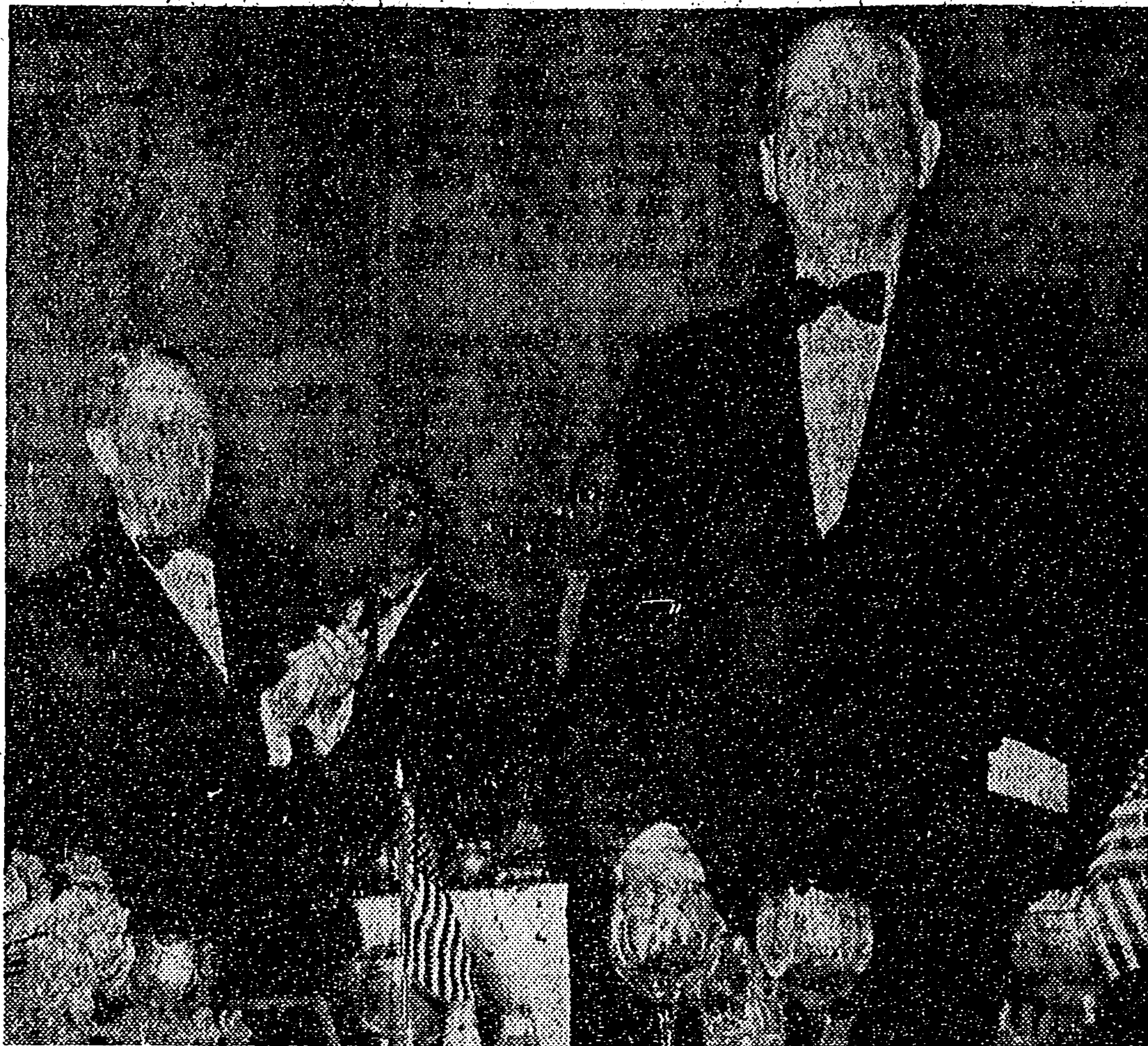
The Pennsylvanians, paced by Bob Mlkvy, a senior, and J. D. Graham, a sophomore, were never headed by the middies. Mlkvy and Graham netted 18 points each. Bill Kirvan led Navy with 14.

Navy, behind by as many as 12 points, closed the gap to 48—46 midway in the final period on a 6-point splurge by Kirvan. However, the Quakers scored the next nine points for a 57-46 advantage.

The middies, whose record now is one and one, trailed Penn at half-time, 36—29.
