

Temple Beats Penn

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 21 (AP) — North Carolina State withstood a rally and beat La Salle College, 71—68, in a basketball game tonight at the Palestra.

In the second game, Temple pulled away in the last ten minutes and defeated Penn, 72—58. The loss was Penn's first after four victories. Temple has won seven of eight games.

North Carolina State, scoring its sixth victory in seven games, saw a 62-54 lead with 6:30 left cut to 64—63 on Bill Raftery's steal and a full-court drive with 3:22 to play.

Anton Muehlbauer led the Wolfpack with 19 points.
