NEW HAVEN, Conn., Jan. 9 (AP)—Yale snapped a five-game losing streak and scored its second Ivy League victory of the season tonight, beating Pennsylvania, 67—57, in basketball.

Penn's Bob Mlkvy, who frequently gets 20 points or more, was held to 13, mainly by the fine defending of Yale's John Dowd.

The rival captains led their teams in scoring. Dan McFadden of Yale got 22 points and Penn's Joe Cook made 20.

The Quakers worked to a 16—9 lead at the midpoint of the first half. They still were ahead by 7 minutes later. But then they went cold and Yale poured in 7 straight to tie the score, 27—27, at half-time.

For the rest of the game it was all Yale. Penn had a tie briefly at 29—29 when each team scored one goal at the opening of the second half. Then Yale went ahead and made the lead stick.

With McFadden showing the way, the Elis raced to a 39-29 lead.

The victory left Yale 2—1 in the league and 4—7 over-all. Penn has one victory and two losses in Ivy competition and stands 5—6 for the season.
