

ST. JOSEPH'S TOPS HOFSTRA BY 70-64

Hoy Paces Philadelphians With 26-Point Total

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 5 (AP) — Billy Hoy scored 26 points and led St. Joseph's College to a 70-64 victory over Hofstra College in the opener of a college basketball double-header at the Palestra tonight.

Penn defeated Rutgers, 101-57, in the second game.

With the score 67-64 in the opener, Hofstra began fouling in an effort to get the ball. Jim Boyle missed two free throws for St. Joseph's but Hoy got the rebound and was fouled with 24 seconds left. He made one of the two shots and moments later Jim Lynam added two foul shots for the final margin.
