

PENN TURNS BACK NAVY FIVE, 73-58

Pawlak Scores 26 Points as Victors Win 2d in Row

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 7 (AP)—A tight zone defense and the shooting of Stan Pawlak carried Penn's basketball team to a 73-58 victory over Navy tonight.

Pawlak, a sophomore, sank nine field goals and eight free throws for 26 points. The victory was the second in two starts for Penn. It was Navy's first defeat after two victories.
