

Penn Wins in Overtime

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 10 (AP)—A foul shot by Jeff Neuman with three seconds remaining in an overtime period gave Penn a 70-69 victory tonight over Yale in an Ivy League game.

Penn ended its five-game losing streak and sent Yale to its fifth straight defeat.

Two free throws in the last 46 seconds gave La Salle a 63-61 victory over Syracuse in the second game of the double-header. It was the Explorers ninth victory in a row.
