

## Penn Beats Brown, 75-64

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 11 (AP)—Stan Pawlak and Jeff Neuman, two sophomores, combined for 43 points tonight in leading Penn to its second Ivy League victory of the season, 75—64, over Brown.

In the second game, Steve Courtin hit a field goal and a pair of free throws in the last two minutes to give St. Joseph's a 53-52 victory over Temple in a Middle Atlantic Conference game.

Pawlak got 25 points and Neuman 18 as Penn turned the game into a rout in the final 10 minutes.
