

Penn Beats Dartmouth

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 15 (UPI)—Penn remained in contention for the Ivy League championship tonight by defeating Dartmouth, 67—48.

Temple defeated La Salle, 63—57, in the second game of the double-header.

Penn's victory was its seventh against two defeats in the Ivy League. Dartmouth, now 0—9 against league rivals, stayed with the Quakers most of the first half, which ended with Penn leading, 35—29.
