

## South Carolina Tops Penn

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 11 (UPI)—Unbeaten South Carolina gained its fourth victory in a row tonight by downing Pennsylvania, 42-39, at the Palestra.

Playing in a semi-freeze after jumping to a 12-7 lead at the outset, South Carolina held a 39-34 lead in the final minutes. Penn came back with two baskets to make it 39-38. With 17 seconds remaining, the Gamecocks led, 40-39. Then Stan Pawlak, Penn's leading scorer with 16 points, missed a free throw that would have tied the score. Frank Standard clinched the game for South Carolina with two free throws with 7 seconds to go.
