

YALE BEATS ARMY IN LACROSSE, 12-8

Bradford Scores 4 Goals to Spark Eli Team

NEW HAVEN, April 23—

Yale's lacrosse team rallied for six goals in the second period and four more in the third to score a 12-8 victory over previously undefeated Army today in the Yale Bowl.

Mac Bradford led the Elis with four goals, while Joe Upton and Bruce Corbridge added three each. Warren Dempsey scored four times for Army.

The victory gave Yale a 6-2 won-lost record. Army is 3-1.
