

ROCHESTER, Dec. 28 (AP)—The University of Pennsylvania won the Kodak Classic basketball tourney tonight in a second-half surge; defeating the University of Rochester, 69-57.

A jump shot by Rice's Greg Williams in the last 11 seconds of play gave Rice a 71-69 victory over Seton Hall in the consolation game.

Penn was down by 8 points at the half, 34-26, but steady shooting from the floor proved to be the key to success. Penn averaged 48 per cent over Rochester's 32 per cent in field goals.

Penn's Dave Wohl, a 6-foot sophomore guard was high for the winners iwth 22 points and guard Steve Bilski added 18. Bilski dumped seven from the foul line in the last 10 minutes.

Jackson Collins was high for Rochester with 12 points.

Greg Williams of Rice won the most-valuable-player honors for his 53 points during the two-day tournament.
