

PENN FIVE DOWNS CORNELL BY 73-56

Victory at Palestra Is 5th in
League—Temple Wins

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 7 (AP)

—Three sophomores paced the University of Pennsylvania to a 73-56 Ivy League victory over Cornell tonight at the Palestra.

In the second game of the basketball double-header, Temple routed Lafayette, 72-53.

Steve Bilsky led the Quakers with 23 points, while John Koller scored 16 and Dave Wohl had 13. The triumph, Penn's 10th in 18 games, raised the Quakers' league record to 5-2. Cornell, which is 8-10 over all, has a 3-4 Ivy mark.
