NEW HAVEN, Feb. 15 — Pennsylvania remained tied for second place with Columbia in the Ivy League basketball race tonight, beating Yale, 67-60, for their sixth straight victory.

Steve Bilsky, a sophomore, scored 17 of his 22 points in the second half to pace the Quakers, now 8-2 in Ivy play and 13-8 over all. Jim Morgan tallied 20 points for Yale, now 5-5 in the league and 8-13 over all.
