PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 20 (AP) —Steve Bilsky made a free throw with 2 minutes 14 seconds left for a 53-52 lead, the 13th time the lead changed hands in the second half, and Penn went on to defeat Villanova 59-55, in the second game of a double-header at the Palestra tonight.

In the first game, Temple broke open a close battle early in the second half and handed Delaware its first loss, 79-63.
