

# PENN FIVE SCORES OVER BROWN, 84-56

## Ivy League Leaders Post 16th Straight Victory

PROVIDENCE, R. I., Feb. 21 (AP)—Penn rolled to its 16th straight victory and 23d in 24 games tonight by crushing Brown, 84-56, in an Ivy League basketball game. The league leaders have won all 12 of their games.

Penn, ranked seventh nationally, rolled to a 41-16 half-time lead and used all 14 players in equaling its highest victory output in 52 years.

Bob Morse, a 6-foot-8-inch sophomore, led the Quakers with 16 points.

Brown, which managed just 14 field goals, was topped by Arnie Berman with 22 points, including 14 of 17 from the free-throw line.

The defeat left Brown with a 5-17 over all record and 2-10 in the league.
