

PENN OVERCOMES YALE FIVE BY 91-77

Unbeaten Quakers Register
20th Victory of Season

NEW HAVEN, Feb. 13 (UPI)—Pennsylvania became the first major college basketball team in the East to win 20 games this season when it defeated Yale, 91-77, tonight.

The Quakers, unbeaten, spurted late in the first half to win their 8 straight Ivy League game. Yale is 3-15 for the season and 1-7 in the league.

Phil Hankinson, a 6-foot-8 sophomore, had a career high of 21 points and Dave Wohl added 16 to pace the Quakers. Scott Michel scored 24 and Jim Morgan 20 for Yale. Penn had a 53-41 edge in rebounding, with Hankinson getting 12, Michel had 14 rebounds for Yale.
