

PENN'S LATE SHOT BEATS ST. JOSEPH'S

Quakers Triumph by 54-53
—Navy Upsets Temple

PHILADELPHIA, Dec. 13 (AP)—Ron Haigler sank a 10-foot jump shot as time ran out to give ninth-ranked Penn a 54-53 victory over St. Joseph's tonight.

In the first game of the college basketball double-header at the Palestra, Navy scored only six field goals in the second half but nevertheless upset Temple, 66-58.

Mike Bantom had sent St. Joseph's ahead on a five-foot jumper with 17 seconds remaining after the Hawks had blown an 11-point lead in the second half.

Haigler's winning shot came off an out-of-bounds play from under the St. Joseph's basket that started with two seconds showing on the clock.
