

PENN FIVE EDGES MANHATTAN, 52-51

Haigler's Basket at Buzzer Gives Quakers Victory

PHILADELPHIA, Jan. 20 (AP)—Ron Haigler's five-foot jumper at the buzzer gave Penn a 52-51 victory over Manhattan tonight in the second game of a college double-header at the Palestra.

Earlier, Mike Banton scored 30 points and grabbed 14 rebounds to lead St. Joseph's to a 96-69 victory over Fairfield.

Manhattan had built a 34-20 half-time lead by outscoring the Quakers, 16-4, in the last nine minutes. Bill Campion did most of the damage for the Jaspers, drawing six personal fouls and going 7 for 9 from the line.

But Campion was charged with his fourth foul with 14 minutes 22 seconds left and Manhattan leading, 38-26.

L.I.U. outrebounded the losers, 48-33, with Ruben Rodriguez pulling down 15 rebounds and adding 17 points. Glenn Price led the losers with 20 points.

The victory was L.I.U.'s sixth in 13 games, while the loss dropped the Indians to a 6-8 won-lost mark.

Tennessee Edges Kentucky

KNOXVILLE, Tenn., Jan. 20 (AP)—Rodney Woods scored on a 10-foot jump shot with 52 seconds left as Tennessee edged Kentucky, 65-64, today in a Southeastern Conference game. The victory gave Tennessee possession of second place in the conference. Kentucky is now 3-2 in the league and 8-5 over all.

Kentucky had the ball on out-of-bounds plays three times in the last 15 seconds but was unable to get off a shot. Larry Robinson clinched the triumph when he intercepted a pass with three seconds remaining and held the ball.
