

Penn Wins, Stays Tied With Brown

PROVIDENCE, R. I., Feb. 15 (AP)—Jim Busam, with 18 points, and Phil Brown, with 15, sparked Brown to a 71-56 victory over Columbia tonight in an Ivy League game at the Providence Civic Center.

Brown trailed much of the first half, but scored 7 straight points and took a 3-point half-time lead.

Brown now has a 13-6 won-lost mark, including eight victories in nine Ivy League games and is tied for first with Pennsylvania.

Yale Routs Cornell

NEW HAVEN, Feb. 15—Jim McGuire and Tim Kearns scored 20 points apiece tonight in leading Yale to a 107-72 rout of Cornell. The victory lifted Yale's won-lost record to 7-12 for the season and 4-5 in the Ivy League, while the Big Red dropped their eighth game in nine Ivy League outings and 18th in 21 games over all.

Trailing, 44-34, at the half, Harvard tied the score at 48-48 with 14:28 left, and again at 54-54 with 11:28 remaining. Penn is 16-5 overall, Harvard is 8-11.

GENEVA, N. Y., Feb. 15 (AP)—Rich Kolmetz scored 20 points tonight in leading Hobart to a 78-74 victory over Cortland State. Hobart led, 48-36, at the half.

Oswego State Triumphs
