

Princeton Turns Back Columbia Five by 69-53

PRINCETON, N. J., Feb. 6 (AP)—Princeton built a big lead in the first half, then easily scored its fifth straight Ivy League victory, 69-53 over Columbia tonight.

Leading, 19-11, eight minutes into the game, the Tigers scored 11 straight points, including 6 by a sophomore forward, Frank Sowinski. In the second half, Princeton's 10-point streak put the club up by 61-40.

A senior guard, Mickey Steurer, had six assists and eight steals as the Tigers' tight defense forced Columbia to turn the ball over 25 times.

Princeton leads the Ivy League with its 5-0 record. Columbia is 3-2.

Penn 94, Cornell 54

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 6—Two guards sparked Pennsylvania to a 94-54 Ivy League rout of Cornell at the Palestra tonight. Stanley Greene, a reserve guard, scored 20 points for the Quakers and a backcourt mate, Mark Lonetto, added 16.

Penn is 8-8 over all, 3-2 in the league. Cornell is 5-12, with 1-5 in the league.

Dartmouth 76, Yale 54

HANOVER, N. H., Feb. 6 (AP)—Dartmouth rolled to

its fifth straight victory tonight, beating Yale, 76-54, in an Ivy League game.

N. C. State 102, Furman 76

CHARLOTTE, N.C., Feb. 6 (AP)—Kenny Carr scored North Carolina State's first 16 points and the Wolfpack trounced Furman, 102-76, tonight. Carr, a sophomore, entered the game with a 29-point scoring average and equalled that figure in the first half as he hit 13 of 16 shots. He wound up with 39 points.

Brown 58, Harvard 56

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., Feb. 6 (AP)—Brian Saunders hit two free throws with nine seconds left tonight and lifted Brown to a 58-56 Ivy League victory over Harvard.

Harvard had led, 33-28, at half-time, having hit 58 percent from the floor, but Saunders let a Brown rally in the second half. He finished with 22 points and had 12 rebounds. Glenn Fine of Harvard had 12 points and 12 assists.

L.I.U. 76, Buffalo 72

BUFFALO, Feb. 6 (AP)—Nate Revells scored 42 points, a record for Buffalo's floor, and led Long Island University to a 76-72 victory on the Bulls tonight.
