

Penn, 96, Brown 75

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 26 (A.P.)—John Engles triggered an early second-half burst tonight that powered Penn to a 96-75 victory over Brown.

Engles scored 7 points in less than three minutes while the Quakers went on a 12-3 surge that swamped the Bruins.

Penn is 9-2 in the Ivy League race for the title it has won the last six seasons. But the Quakers still trail league-leading Princeton.
