

Penn, Oklahoma Triumph

COLUMBIA, S. C., Dec. 23 (AP)—Tony Price and Keven McDonald led a surge in the second half that carried Pennsylvania to an 88-71 victory over Southern California in the consolation game of the Carolina Classic tonight.

In the tourney final, Oklahoma scored 15 consecutive points in a second-half surge and went on to defeat South Carolina, 65-48.

Pennsylvania led at halftime, 48-46. Price and McDonald then scored 10 points each in the first 10 minutes of the second half as the Quakers took a 72-56 lead with 9:59 remaining in the game.

McDonald, a senior forward, finished with 28 points and Price scored 21. Don Carfino led Southern Cal with 21 points. Pennsylvania evened its record at 3-3 while Southern Cal was left at 5-5.
