

Harvard Hands Penn First Ivy Loss, 93-87

CAMBRIDGE, Mass., Feb. 18 (AP)—
Glenn Fine converted six free throws
in the final 40 seconds tonight and
Harvard defeated Penn, 93-87.

Penn led most of the way and ap-
peared on its way to a 10-0 Ivy League
record. However, the Crimson took the
lead with two minutes remaining and
Fine came through in the clutch.

Harvard, 8-12 for the season and 5-4
in the league, was led by Brian Banks
with 24 points.

Penn's Kevin McDonald took game
honors with 29 for the Quakers.
